Main Tasks & Responsibilities

- > Assisting the Teacher in the classroom with a variety of activities in a special education environment, such as preparing the classroom with a variety of activities and resources.
- > Working with children individually or in small groups (12-15 students per class).
- > Oversee the lunch and recess program.
- > Planning and implementing curriculum with the classroom teacher's guidance.
- > Ability to work within a multi-disciplinary team.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Teachers.
- > Step into the Teacher role when the Teacher is absent, on occasion.
